ACADEMIC COSTUME INFORMATION

Caps

The cap at the University of Minnesota is the same for all academic degrees. The long point of the shell should be worn to the rear.

Tassels

Tassels are fastened to the top of the cap and hang on either side "as the wind blows." Tassels for University College are old gold and white.

Honors Cord

Undergraduate degree candidates who are graduating with honors (cum laude, magna cum laude & summa cum laude) should wear the honors cords on the right shoulder and the arm should be slopped through the insigna loop. Either color may come first.

Hoods


The hood is the most outstanding feature of the American academic costume. The length and shape of the hood indicates the degree that is granted; the lining displays the official colors of the university, and the velvet trim indicates the field of study. The lining of the University of Minnesota hood is maroon and gold.
